ank 1 â€" sensor 1 would be:. A bad oxygen sensor can affect the mixture greatly. There could also potentially be raw fuel that enters the exhaust. This fuel can hurt the catalytic converter. One of the most common symptoms that an oxygen sensor has gone bad is exhaust that does not smell good. This is especially true if the mixture ends up too lean. While a rough running engine can be a sign of a bad oxygen sensor, it is often a sign of a misfire as well. Without a check engine light, it can be tough to lock down exactly what would cause the vehicle to fail, but oxygen sensors are one of the more common causes. It is smart to use a scan tool to determine whether or not there is an OBDII trouble code associated with any of the sensors. Good luck diagnosing your Taurus!
